

History is taught through our Discovery Quest topics in all year groups.

Some Discovery Quest topics have a specific history focus.

Links are made to previous learning in history and are then built upon.

Children go on trips/visits that are history based, e.g. to Black Country museum, Birmingham museum, etc.

A subject leader report is written for governors at the end of each school year.

History at Little Bloxwich



Children in all year groups learn about important historical dates/ events each year, including- Black history month, Remembrance Day, Holocaust Memorial day, Saints days and V.E day.

What does it look like?

Monitoring of history work takes place by the subject leader.

Subject leader meets with co-ordinators from two local schools to share ideas and good practice.

Skills progression ladders are in place and are used by Reception to Year 6.

Class assemblies and Inspire workshops often link to history.
