

Weekly guided reading sessions to teach reading skills.

81% of children achieved EXS in reading - above national average.

39% of children achieved GDS in reading - above national average.

Year 6 2020

Prediction: 40% GDS

Daily reading activities for fluency.

KS1 children take home two books. The first book is phonics matched and the other is for wider reading.

Reading and writing are taught together to ensure a consistent link between reading and writing skills with quality texts.

Reading at Little Bloxwich



KS2 children take home two books.

One book is matched to the child's reading level while the other is a reading for pleasure book.

What does it look like?

Story time at the end of the day in each year group, promoting a love of reading.

World Book Day and Poetry Day celebrated across school.

New KS2 library with seated area for quiet reading and work tables.

Year 6 children given 'librarian' jobs.

Class book boxes of familiar stories for the children to draw upon and re-read. This progresses with three books added in each year group.

Reading diaries are taken home and encouraged to be signed weekly.

Each KS2 class has a timetabled slot to use the library and every child has a library book to take home for reading for pleasure.

83% of children passed the phonics check in 2019 - above national average.

All children are heard read by an adult weekly and with their class teacher every half term.
