


George what a fantastic Shadow puppet theatre. I bet you had great fun making it?

Still on a science theme, Abigail shared with us photos of her science investigations. Well done Abigail






Abigail has also been on Classroom Secret Kids and completed the VE Day Quiz.

Remember you need to keep playing 'studio' to move up on the leader board.




Also a big well done to our year 6 children who gave the greatest contribution to the battles. (Abigail, Katie and Layla)
